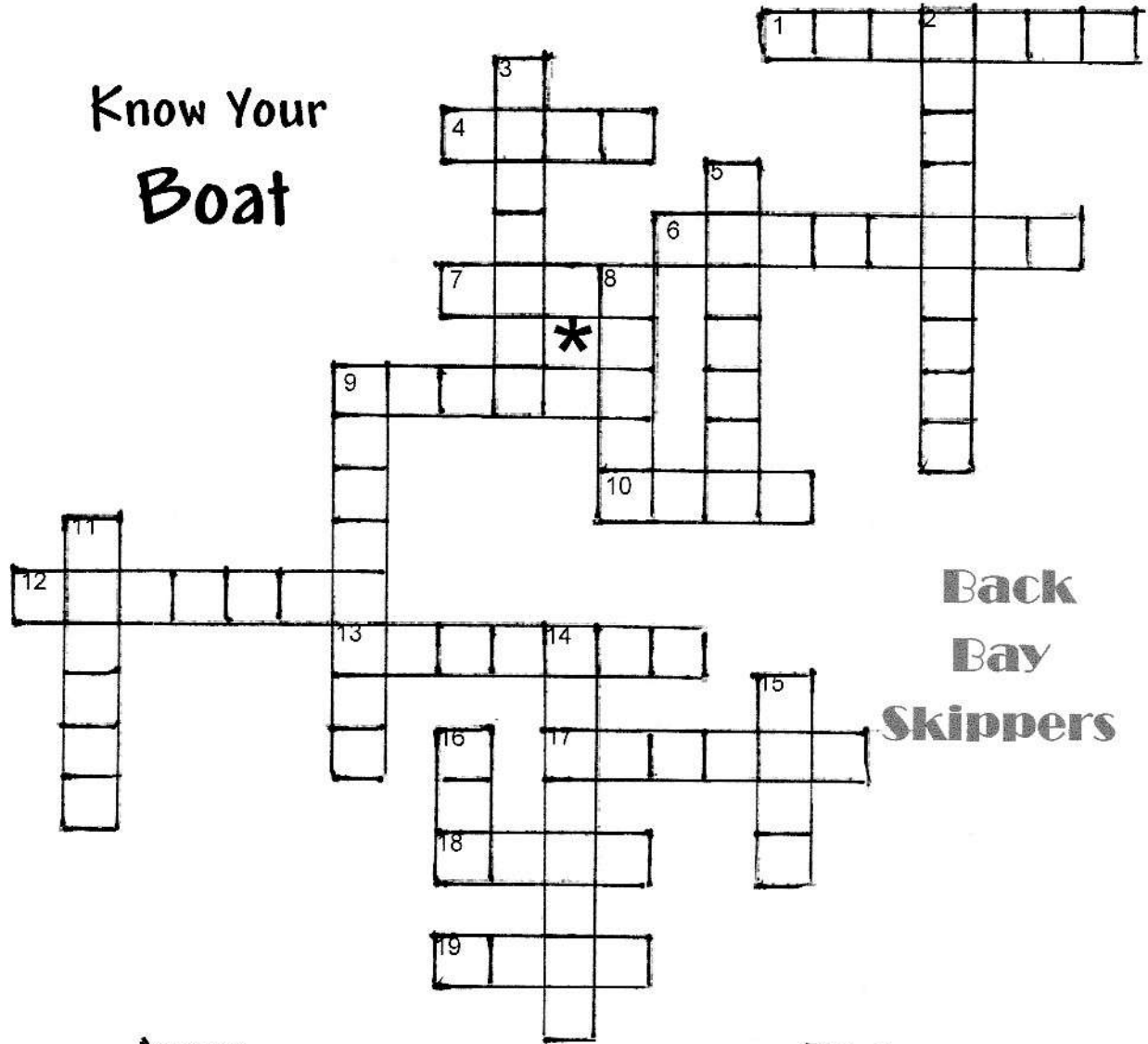

| <p>1 Many parts: lines, sails, mast & boom</p> <p>4 A vertical pole for supporting sails</p> <p>6 Wall-like constructions inside a vessel</p> <p>7 A fixed part underwater to provide stability</p> <p>9 A simple device, with 3 holes, for tensioning</p> <p>10 Body of the boat</p> <p>12 Wires, to the sides, that hold the mast upright</p> <p>13 Back part of the boat that is perpendicular to its centerline</p> <p>17 Movable underwater steering device</p> <p>18 Maximum width of boat</p> <p>19 Aft lower corner of the sail</p> | <p>2 A hinged fitting on the mast that connects the mast to the boom</p> <p>3 Slats inserted in sail for added support</p> <p>5 A sail control that allows tensioning of the foot</p> <p>8 Aft edge of sail</p> <p>9 Runs from top of mast to the stern</p> <p>11 All lines on a boat which are used to control the in & out motion of sail</p> <p>14 Struts to increase the power of the shrouds</p> <p>15 A platform in a ship</p> <p>16 Another name for headsail</p> |
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
