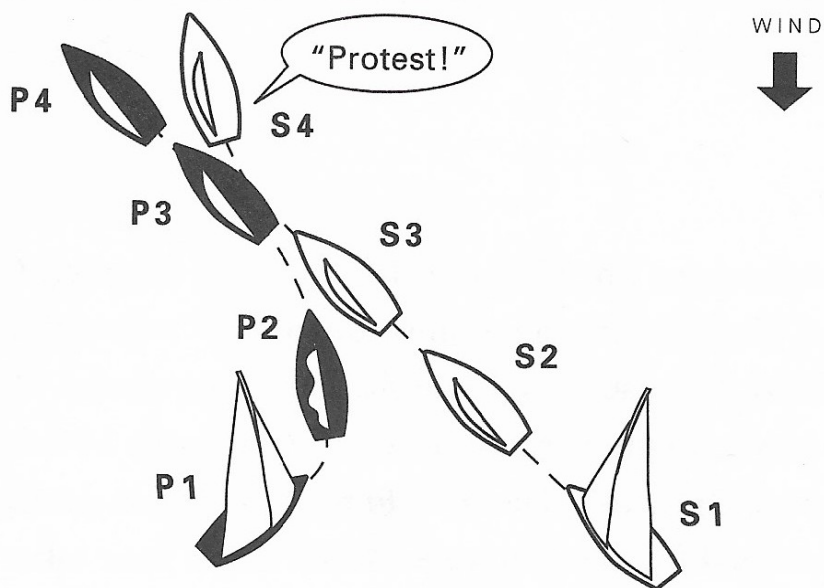


Quiz 10
