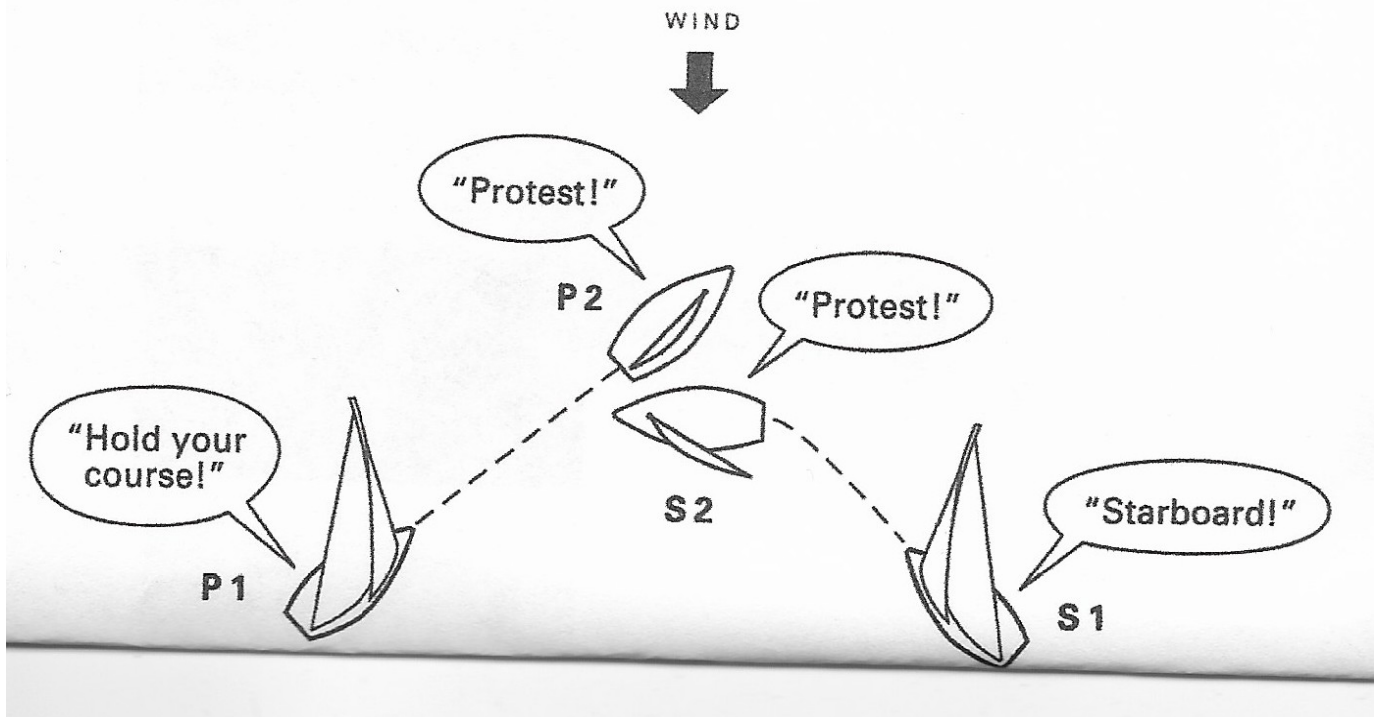


Quiz 7
